Implementation of IVFRT and Biometric System Introduction of Biometrics, Appointment for physical submission of application for Visa.

The High Commission of India will switch over to Online Visa Application Filing for all applicants and all visa types w.e.f. 15.11.2019. Manually filled-in visa applications are no longer accepted.

Biometric Data collection, including fingerprint data and facial imagery will be a mandatory requirement for all type visa applicants from 15.11.2019. As a result, all visa applicants will need to first apply online. Visa Application Registration Form available on Website: <http://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/> and, thereafter, be physically present (mandatorily) at High Commission of India, Georgetown, Guyana, for submission of visa application and biometric data enrolment.

The printed form should be submitted physically in the High Commission on the same day or subsequent days along with: (i) Passport, (ii) Additional photographs, (iii) Fees, (iv) Other documentation required for the type of visa applied for, and any other relevant supporting documents.
